Kindergarten Fees 2011 2012

Children may only attend school after the financial interview and with a signed financial agreement.

(The voucher scheme is dependent on the present government maintaining this scheme. Lancaster Steiner School reserves the right to change this Fee Policy in accordance with any change in Government policy.)

Extended funding/parental contributions (no sibling discount applicable)

The Provision of part-time Early Years extended funding offers parents the chance to facilitate 15 hours a week of free child care, spread over no more than two providers. The full 15 hours can be claimed over no less than 3 days.

The table below sets out the **basic** fee structure for the various options that we offer parents. The extra days needed to comply with our term-times will be added on an individual basis.

Our Afternoon Club is open to all children at £5,50 per session, or £2.20 for Lunch club.

★ Parent's who wish to access Afternoon Club through the extended funding, must have booked their places at the beginning of each term. Voucher funding cannot be claimed retrospectively

2 days a week basic/with or without lunch club: £381.84 p/a	= £31.82 p/m
pm Club can be funded by vouchers for these days at no extra cost to parents	

3 days a week basic/ with or without lunch club: £572.76 p/a	= £45 p/m
pm club over the one day covered by the vouchers can be arranged and paid for at the current rate.	

4 days a week basic with or without lunch club: £794.64 p/a	= £62.50 p/m
lunch club over the one day covered by the vouchers and pm club can be arranged and paid for at the current rate.	

5 days a week:	£1,780.12 p/a	= £148.34 p/m
The lunch club and afternoon club are available for all children and can be paid for at the current rate		

Increasing your child's days in Kindergarten:

Our school policy states that children should increase from 2 mornings to 3 mornings after the first term. Any further increase can be arranged with Kindergarten, and payments adjusted beforehand through the school office.

Kindergarten Sessions that are missed will still be charged.

Kindergarten Per-Child Fees for children over five years of age.

Assisted places (15% of family's net income) and a limited number of bursary places may be applied for. Financial agreements are set up only after application forms have been processed and any bursary awards given.

£3,120 p/a for a child in kindergarten 5 days per week
(£17.05 per day) **£ 260 p/m**

Oldest child pays full fee; first sibling receives a **33%** discount,
Subsequent sibling/s **66%** discount.

Over 5s are entitled to the same assisted and/or bursary places as lower school children, except that the maximum fee is the 5 days' kindergarten fee of **£3,120**
